Another week or two and the repairs to the stonework should be complete, after which the wall will be sealed to prevent any further damp. Sadly, the inside is going to take years to dry out, so no quick fix there. We know that it is inconvenient not being able to access the west side of the churchyard, but please respect the orange fence boundary at all times. We do not want anybody to come to harm. The tower clock was serviced last week and is working for now, although it's not clear why it stopped in the first place. You won't hear it chiming for a little while until the building works are complete, as we protect the ears of our hard-working builders. We have also taken advantage of the scaffold being up to have the clock face repainted, something we had been waiting to do for a while. You may also notice that the shed in the Cloisters' garden has been replaced, allowing us more storage space and, hopefully, an opportunity to sort out what we have in our various store cupboards - so if you see us looking a little dusty in the coming weeks, you'll know why!
