Buildings Update

The boiler room roof has been replaced; the tower and west wall pointing is being finished; the clock **face** has been regilded, and the clock mechanism serviced and it is in a working order. The tower **stone steps** are felt to be unsafe and therefore we have not been able to access the winding mechanism. We have now received approval of our repair method, and so we hope to have everything safe, clean and working in the next 2-3 weeks. Work will soon begin on redecorating **the** front porch; and levelling the entrance floor to ease access; we are awaiting planning permission to install the glass door which is likely to take some time. Meanwhile at St Luke's the very uneven path has been beautifully paved and the drains are being repaired.
