- After sanitising your hands, please follow the one-way system and go straight to your pew and refrain from socialising along the way.
- You will find everything you need for the Service on your pew seat. Sadly, community singing is still not allowed.
- Your kind donations should be placed in the envelopes provided and popped into a basket held by a Steward as you leave the church, thank you
- At the end of the Service, please remain in your pew until you are directed to leave by a Steward and follow the one-way system
- As you are leaving, please again refrain from socialising inside the church
